Paraiso de Miguel is a magnificent tropical paradise surrounded by modern convenience. This duplex villa was built in 2004 and sits 600 feet above the Golfo Dulce. The backyard offers 120-degree ocean views, which are accented by the lush jungle surroundings. The mountains of the Osa peninsula drape the crystal blue waters of the gulf creating a collage of tropical wonder. This is truly a place where nature meets its origin.

Bathroom includes a large walk in shower and bathtub built for two, both of which are supplied by an endless flow of hot water from tankless water heaters.

Kitchen is fully equipped for your convenience: Refrigerator and freezer, cook top with oven, coffee maker, blender, toaster, microwave, a full assortment of pots, pans, Tupperware and place settings for 12. Whether preparing meals in the kitchen or BBQing on the deck, you will always be entertained by the ocean view and wild life.



Back patio offers a stainless steel BBQ, Adirondack chairs and hammocks for sunset viewing and afternoon napping, ceiling fan and outside "rain drop" shower.

Backyard has 50 tropical fruit trees that offer seasonal bananas, papaya, mango, water apples, pineapple and all varieties of citrus fruits. There is also a seasonal stream that provides a

home to a variety of frogs, parrots, toucans, sloths and monkeys,

House is supplied with pure well water that is pulled from an underground aquifer below the property.

Unit also has it's own washer and dryer.



Waterfalls and swimming holes within a 5 to 10 minute walk from the house.

In the early mornings and evenings, enjoy the wide variety of birds, including parrots and toucans that begin their day visiting the numerous trees surrounding the property. You can also find White face, howler and squirrel monkeys migrating through the property at different times of the day.
